### **2021 PRINCE PHILIP CUP – NSWIDA and RSYS:**

Brad confirmed dates 2/1/2022 to 9/1/2022, Club – RSYS, on Sydney Harbour.

Discussion with RSYS is continuing and it is looking like the Regatta will be less formal in an effort to reduce costs.

Rod advised could be up to 5 WA boats entering

Brad advised 6 NSW boats are expected to be completing

### **SAYONARA CUP:**

Brad advised it is a Royal Clubs Regatta, not a Class Regatta, and it is out of the NSWIDA hands. He will speak with Richard Franklin, who is on the Sailing Committee of the RSYS, for

an update. He is hoping that it will be held as part of the 2022 PPC, which would enable all states to compete.

**BOAT REGISTRATION FEE:**

Due to the reduced sailing over the past 12 months, each state is to advise number of registered boats to the Secretary and an invoice will then be forwarded to each state.

**ACTION**

Traditionally there has been 50 boats registered with IDA, which enables Australia to have 10 automatic entries into Worlds Championships. To be discussed further when the number of registered boats is known.

**IDA TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:**

Ian Malley advised that the unsinkable Dragon is still being actioned. Petticrow has moved it factory to Portugal. He asked that each state advise him with current measurers who are accredited by Australian Sailing. **ACTION**

**PROMOTION:**

Jennie advised that site info is showing that 55% of emails are being opened, which is well above commercial business expectation. Continue to send news articles to update website, newsletters, etc to Susan.

Susan asked for an update list of boats with current owners. David to provide a list provided by Leigh Edwards, which will forward to each state by the Secretary. **ACTION**
